- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:32 P.M.

- 17. The contractor bids for the new station were opened last week. We are going through the proposals and will come up with some kind of ranking for them. BRW is checking the references listed on the proposals. We will have a conference call with them next Thursday to compare notes and narrow the 9 bids down to 3. Once we have narrowed down the search we will have the contractors come in for a presentation and talk to people we know in town that has used these contractors in the past. Motion to proceed made by Commissioner Ames and seconded by Commissioner Hambric. Motion carried unanimously.
- 18. We have a trial version of Firehouse Software that the Fire Marshal is trying out for inspections. We do not want to purchase the suppression side of the program yet. The City of El Paso is testing it out now. ESD #2 is using the whole program now. Tami will go down soon to look at the program. If the City decides to go with the program 911 may purchase for the City and County entities. Motion to approve \$2200 for the purchase of the inspection side of the program made by Commissioner Hambric and seconded by Commissioner Rubio. Motion carried unanimously.
- 19. Motion to table as we are still waiting on proposals made by Commissioner McLellan and seconded by Commissioner Ames. Item tabled.
- 20. Motion to approve \$1572 for the purchase of new badges for the firefighters as all their unit numbers are changing made by Commissioner Hambric and seconded by Commissioner Rubio. Motion carried unanimously.
- 21. Motion to approve purchases of training C.D.'s through the Action Training Grant we received made by Commissioner Hambric and seconded by Commissioner Ames. Motion carried unanimously.
