**A RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX RATE
BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
FOR THE EL PASO COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #1
OF EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR COMMENCING
OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Commissioners for the Emergency Services District #1 of El Paso County, Texas, that:

The Board of Commissioners for and on behalf of the El Paso County Emergency Services District #1, do hereby set the property tax rate for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021, at the rate of 0.100000 per \$100.00 of property value, consisting of an I&S tax rate of 0.031965 and a M&O tax rate of 0.068035.


THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 2.46% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000.00 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$2.40.

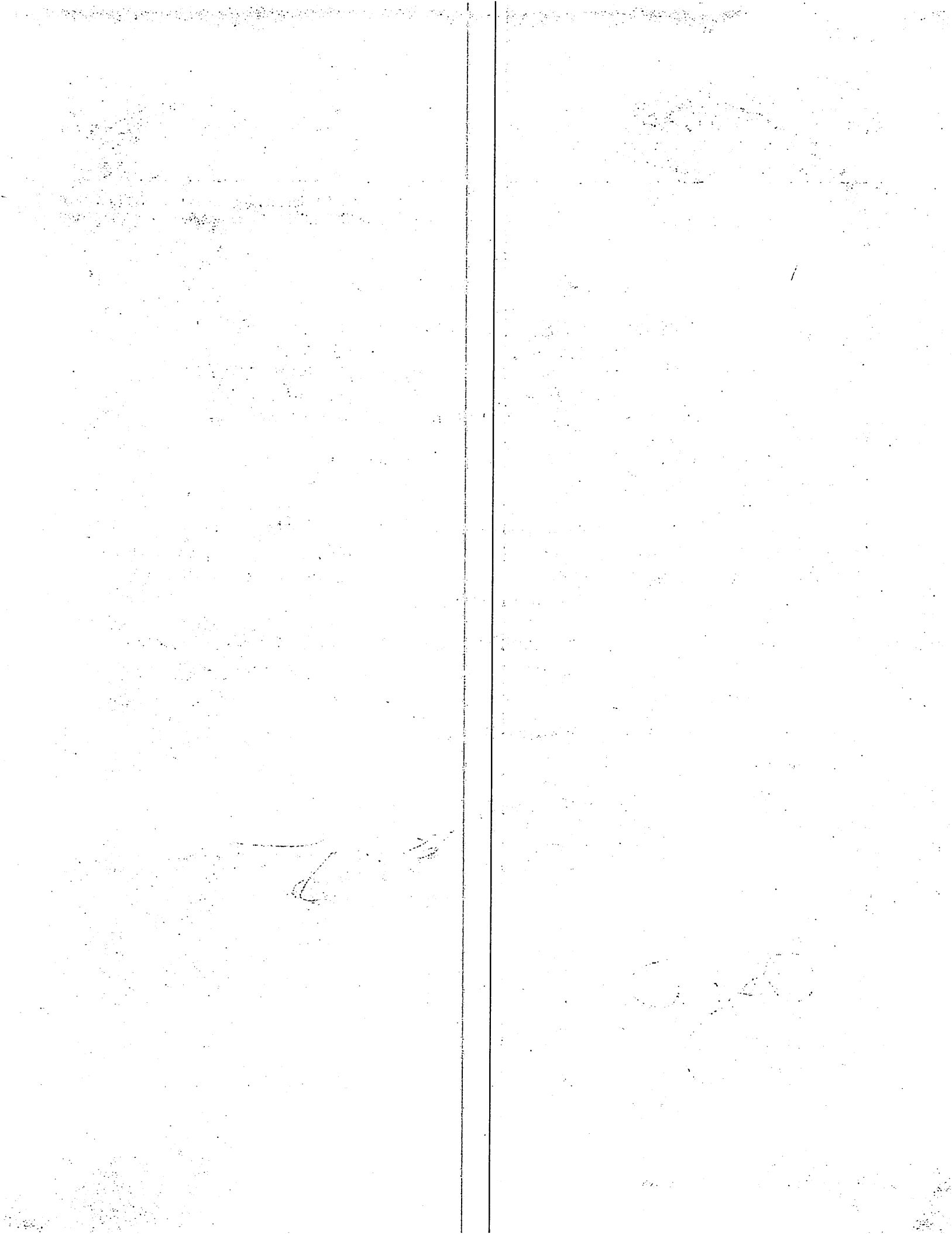




